## SACKETS HARBOR BATTLEFIELD AND THE ALLIANCE

The Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site is a cultural heritage site in northern New York State. Operated by the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, it is the only state historic site located in the Thousand Islands Parks Region. State operated since 1967, the site encompasses 31 acres with ten structures on site and the nearby former Union Hotel.

The story of the site, from the War of 1812 through the 1950's, tells of a strategic military presence on these grounds. From the largest U. S. navy fleet to sail during the War of 1812 to the first U. S. naval station commanded by a woman, the Sackets Harbor Battlefield State Historic Site boasts a long and fascinating history.

However, preservation of this cultural heritage site comes at a price:

- The price to maintain the grounds, memorial tree grove, stone wall and the historic and modern structures.

- The price to staff the site's interpretive programming and publishing efforts, and
- The price to promote this historic treasure on the eastern shore of Lake Ontario.
